
## Structure



## **Definitions**

- A Learning Block refers to broad knowledge/practice <u>domain</u> within Community Health (e.g., infectious diseases) (duration: from 2 weeks to up to 2 months)
- A Module refers to a broad knowledge/practice <u>sub-domain</u> within Community Health (emerging infectious diseases and epidemics) (duration: from 1 to 2 weeks).
- A **Topic** focuses on a <u>specific aspect of the module</u> (e.g., community-based surveillance of infectious diseases) (duration: from 1 to 2 hours).
  - → Each Topic comprises a "Watch & Learn" <u>video-presentation</u> (e.g., video-lecture, expert interview) complemented by one or more <u>exercises</u> (e.g., in video-quiz, drag & drop, fill in the blanks) and other "Exploring further" <u>additional</u> <u>resources</u> (external videos, articles, trainings, etc.)
- "Reflect, Collaborate & Discuss" are individual or group reflection activities, analysis leading to a production (duration: 30min to 1hr)
- "Discover & practice" are <u>field workshops</u> led by operational partners and involve practical sessions outside the classroom (duration: 1 or several days)
- "Speak up!" are weekly online meetings were participants meet experts and can ask their questions (duration: 2hrs)
- "Test & go" are <u>assessments</u> based on close ended questions adapted from module exercises (duration: 20min to 40min)
