




In the same way, you must click to an external link in **Speak up!** section if you want to share questions or thoughts to prepare the a "live session".

Once you reach the interactive wall (*padlet*), double click anywhere or click the  icon to add a message. Start writing or click the  icon to audio record  or video record  your message and  it. "Like" the questions  from other students that you would like to ask to the experts as well. You can add comments to these questions if you want to. The questions will be ranked and addressed by experts during the "live session" according to the number of  they get.



Once you finish a module's book, you will be able to test



your knowledge with a **graded quiz**. In **Test & Go** section, click the **Start** button to open the quiz. General information on the quiz will be provided. Once you feel ready, click the **Attempt quiz** button and then the **Start attempt** button to launch the quiz.



Once you are done, click the **Finish attempt ...** button. Make sure you have answered to all questions. If not, you can still click the **Return to attempt** button. If yes, click the **Submit all and finish** button twice. Note that your attempt will be validated only when you have clicked the button a second time. Make sure to submit your attempt before time limit expires.



After reviewing your attempt, click the **Finish review** link to come back to the quiz page. Any attempt will earn you a badge which means you can move on to the next module.
