- . They provide care for pregnant women and newborn babies in the communities.
- . They help to educate the communities about preventive health measures.
- . CHWs facilitates connection between the communities, healthcare facilities and professionals through collection of data.

The following are the roles and responsibilities of CHWs

- 1- collect data
- 2- deliver medicines

3- create awareness in the community

4- they made home visits to the patients at home such as mothers and children with health problems

5- link the health management and the community through delivering data services
